The University of Louisville's John W. Shumaker Research Building Cleanroom is the state's largest controlled-environment "core" facility needed for the fabrication of miniature devices. The center is housed within the new 10,000 square foot, seven bay, class 100 facility, designed by nationally-renown AGI Consultants.

This cleanroom, with the widest variety of micro/nano processing tools in the Southeast, allows UofL researchers to use a wide range of equipment to fabricate, package, and test various microelectronic devices and circuits.

With over 10 years of operating experience, this state-of-the-art facility has been utilized extensively by researchers at U of L and other Universities throughout the Ohio Valley region, as well as industry and government laboratories nationwide.

We will get an early start (11:00) at the University Club at for lunch and a brief introductory presentation. Then, we will walk the short distance to the Research Building for a tour of the laboratories, each of which is separated by various differential air pressures.
