RP-1284 Test Method for Assessing the Performance of Pulse Cleaned Industrial Air Cleaning Filters

Topic:

Blue Heaven Technologies has recently completed a research initiative funded by ASHRAE. RP-1284 is a test method developed for assessing the performance of pulse cleaned industrial air cleaning filters and equipment. No such method existed prior to this work. The final report has been submitted for review to ASHRAE, and publication is anticipated later this year. A Standards Project Committee (SPC 199) has been formed to develop the research protocol into a published test method.

Bob Burkhead, president of Blue Heaven, will give a presentation to explain the details of the testing method and to report on how local companies can benefit from the research funding that ASHRAE provides.
